Regular Session – March 9, 2020

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: The Perry Central Community School Corporation Board of School Trustees met in a Regular Session on March 9, 2020. The meeting began at 6:32 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance in the Jr-Sr High School Library. Board members Tim Edwards, Glenn Etienne, Joe Flamion, Kevin Etienne and Nan DuPont were present along with Tara Bishop, Superintendent; Jody French, Principal; Phil Zellers, Assistant Principal; Jamie Guillaume, Assistant Principal; Michelle Duncan; Kristi Etienne; and Eric Whittaker representing the *Perry County News*.

HIGHLIGHTS: Jody French introduced Additive Manufacturing students Shea Berkhouse, Vivan Galey, Josh Rogier, and Josh Stilwell who presented the items that they have created on the 3D Printer. The students presented last Friday at Innovate WithIN Competition. Vivian Galey and Josh Stilwell created a back brace to use for football players and athletes, and they are currently working on a soccer shin guard. Shea Berkhouse and Josh Young created wordGate to help kids with the LAMP program for kids with communication challenges; and Josh Rogier created a Hypr-Wheel, which is a replacement wheel that can be used on wheelchairs. Perry Central had 3 of the 10 entries, and we were the only school that had students who had engineered their own product and presented working prototypes. Mrs. French added that even though our students did not come away with first place, they learned a lot and grew in confidence.

<u>PARENT TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT</u>: Kevin Etienne made the motion that was seconded by Glenn Etienne and carried 5-0 to approve the parent transportation contracts with Rusty and Bonnie Hermann, Angie Luttrell, and Elizabeth Patterson.

NON-CERTIFIED EMPLOYEE STIPENDS: Kevin Etienne made the motion that was seconded by Nan DuPont to approve one-time \$150 stipend for all non-certified employees that work 25 hours or more per week.

BUDGET REPORTS: Monthly Appropriation, Revenue, and Fund reports were distributed and board members were given an opportunity to review and question.

SUPERINTENDENT COMMENTS: Superintendent Bishop expressed how impressed she was with the Additive Manufacturing students and how grateful she is that our kids have these types of programs available to them. She commented that the board sets the example for this and how much she appreciates their support and to Mrs. French who works hard and puts in long hours to help make programs like this so successful. She also congratulated the boys basketball team on their win last Tuesday.

BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS: Nan DuPont commended the administrative team on the writing of grants and implementation of the grants to make all the extra programs successful here at Perry Central. The board thanked the Additive Manufacturing students for their presentation and were impressed with all of their hard work.
